

Environmental Health Director

Routt County Environmental Health Director: \$71,053 to \$81,078 annually, plus an excellent benefit package. Routt County Environmental Health is seeking a full-time Environmental Health Director. This position directs the environmental health and consumer protection programs of Routt County and the State of Colorado; collaborates with the Northwest Colorado Visiting Nurse Association (NWCOVNA) in the administration of the memorandum of understanding between Routt County and the VNA for the delivery of core and essential public health services in Routt County, and is responsible for administering the duties of the Environmental Health Director for the Routt County Public Health Agency.

Education/training/experience requirements include: Bachelor's degree in environmental health, health education, epidemiology, health administration and policy, biostatistics, nursing, public administration, or closely related discipline; minimum five years within the last ten years of successful and responsible administrative experience in environmental and public health or closely related field including at least two years experience in supervising environmental and public health professionals.

Licenses and Certifications: Desired-State of Colorado Water Treatment & Wastewater Treatment Plants Operator's Certificates; must possess a valid Colorado Drivers License to operate a County vehicle.

Duties include, but are not limited to: Identifies existing and potential environmental and public health problems and develops appropriate mitigation strategies, develops department goals and objectives; monitors air quality; operates and administers all county-owned water supply, sewage disposal and solid waste disposal facilities; writes and administers environmental health grants, coordinates research projects pertaining to air and water quality; provides technical assistance to the public; reviews planning proposals for compliance; and manages the Routt County Bacteriological Water Lab.
